### **Statement**

The Clinical Placements (Nursing) Policy of Beal University Canada (“BUC” or the “University”) supports the University commitment to provide quality clinical placement sites to all nursing students. The Nursing Program Committee will review this policy annually.

### **Purpose**

The purpose of this policy is to arrange clinical placement sites for the University’s nursing students.

### **Roles and Responsibilities**

The Clinical Placement and Lab Coordinator has responsibility for the implementation of this policy. The Dean of Nursing has oversight of this policy.

### **Policy**

All clinical placements for University nursing students are arranged through the Clinical Placement and Lab Coordinator. Students will not contact agencies, their employees, or other personal contacts directly or indirectly, to discuss or try to arrange placements or preceptors for any course where clinical practice is a requirement. If any person outside of the University offers to assist a student to arrange a clinical placement, the student is asked to politely inform that person that such assistance is not permitted under this policy. In the event that a student is interested in an international placement the Clinical Placement and Lab Coordinator will, at the appropriate time, work with the student to begin the placement process. The processes established by the University for placement must be followed.
